

**Instruction for Formatting the Abstract (Autoreferat) of a Dissertation
Submitted for the Award of the Academic Degree of Doctor**

Language: The abstract must be written in the language of the program. A Georgian-language abstract must be accompanied by an English summary, an English-language abstract by a Georgian summary, and an abstract written in another language by both a Georgian and an English summary. The length of the summary is 500–800 words.

Volume: The volume of the abstract, including one summary, must not exceed 32 pages, and including two summaries – 35 pages; this count includes all pages.

Structure: The title page of the abstract must be formatted in accordance with Appendix 1. The abstract must reflect: the relevance of the topic, its scientific novelty, the objective of the work, the object and methods of the research, the main results of the research and the field of application of the results, information on the volume and structure of the dissertation, the main results of the dissertation by chapter, and general conclusions. The abstract must also contain information on the approbation of the work (presentations at conferences, forums, symposia, seminars), as well as a list of published works, patents, and copyright certificates whose content corresponds to the subject matter of the dissertation and which are included in the dissertation.

Page size: The abstract must be printed on A4-format (297×210 mm) paper with a density of 80 g/m². Orientation – vertical.

Margins: left side – 30 mm, other sides – 20 mm.

Font: The main body of the text must be printed in one of the standard fonts (the following fonts are recommended: Sylfaen, AcadNusx, AcadMtav, Litnux, Literaturuli_BJG_2000), size 12.

Titles of chapters and subchapters: The font size of chapter and subchapter titles may exceed that of the main text. A subchapter must continue on the same page; leaving blank spaces or blank pages is not permitted.

Page numbering: All pages, except the title page, must be numbered sequentially. Pages are numbered at the bottom center, using Arabic numerals. The font size of the page number must be 10.

Line spacing: For the main text, the spacing must be 1.5.

The title page must be formatted as follows – it must include the text: Georgian Technical University, “with the right of manuscript,” the doctoral student's name and surname, the title of the dissertation, the doctoral program, the code, “Abstract of a Dissertation Submitted for the Award of the Academic Degree of Doctor,” Tbilisi, and the year.

The second page must include the name of the institution and structural unit where the work was carried out, the supervisor(s), the reviewers, the session of the dissertation defense board at which the defense of the dissertation will take place, the time (year, month, day, hour) and place (address, building and room number) of the defense of the dissertation. The time and place of the defense of the dissertation are entered by hand. It is signed at the end by the faculty's learned secretary.
