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On the Schedule of Entrance Exams for Master's Programs

at the LEPL Georgian Technical University

On the basis of Order №227 of the Minister of Education and Science of Georgia of April 22, 2009 "On Approval of the Regulations for Conducting Master's Exams and the Rule for Distributing State Educational Master's Grants," the Statute of the LEPL Georgian Technical University, the Regulations on Master's Studies, Resolution N01-05-04/17 of the Academic Council of March 6, 2026, and the Rector's Orders N963357 of July 22, 2026, N966238 of July 23, 2026, and N989055 of July 29, 2026, for the purpose of the organized conduct of the enrollment process for master's programs at the Georgian Technical University in the 2026-2027 academic year,

I HEREBY ORDER:

1. The foreign language exam shall be held on **September 2, 2026** (for those applicants who, in accordance with the master's program admission prerequisite, were unable to present a certificate confirming foreign language proficiency at no less than B2 level, or a document confirming completion of a course corresponding to B2 level), in GTU Building I, at the Examination and Electronic Learning Resources Center (Computer Center 2, 1st floor; Computer Center 1, 6th floor), 68 Kostava St.

- Faculty of Business Technologies (master's program: "Hotel Services Management" — Computer Center 2, 1st floor);
- Faculty of Chemical Technology and Agricultural Sciences (master's programs: "Chemical and Biological Engineering," "Chemical Process Production," "Food Technology," "Environmental Protection Engineering," "Agricultural Hydromelioration," "Viticulture and Enology" (English-language), "Agrarian Technologies," "Forestry," "Animal Husbandry," "Viticulture and Winemaking," "Medicinal Plants and Their Production," and "Food Safety" — Computer Center 2, 1st floor);
- Faculty of Transportation Systems and Mechanical Engineering (master's programs: "Transport," "Logistics," "Mechanical Engineering and Technology," "Entrepreneurial Management," "Industrial Engineering and Technology," "Metallurgy," and "Materials Science" — Computer Center 1, 6th floor);
- Faculty of Architecture, Urban Planning and Design (master's program "Architecture" — Computer Center 1, 6th floor).

- Faculty of Mining Technologies and Sustainable Mountain Development (master's programs: "Applied Geology," "Engineering Geodesy," "Occupational Safety and Health," "Oil and Gas Technologies," "Oil and Gas Technologies" (Russian-language), and "Mining and Geoengineering" — Computer Center 1, 6th floor).

1.1. The results of the foreign language exam shall be published on **September 3, 2026**; appeal applications will be accepted from September 2 until 12:00 noon on September 4, 2026, at the place where the exam was held. The final results, taking appeals into account, shall be published on **September 4, 2026**.

2. The specialization exams for master's programs by faculty shall be held:

2.1. On **September 4, 2026**, in GTU Building I, 68 Kostava St., at the Faculty of Architecture, Urban Planning and Design (auditoriums №403C; 407C; 305):

2.2. On **September 4, 2026**, in GTU Building I, at the Examination and Electronic Learning Resources Center (Computer Center 2, 1st floor; Computer Center 1, 6th floor), 68 Kostava St., according to the following schedule:

9:00 AM

- All master's programs of the Faculty of Mining Technologies and Sustainable Mountain Development — Computer Center 2, 1st floor;
- All master's programs of the Faculty of Transportation Systems and Mechanical Engineering — Computer Center 2, 1st floor;
- The master's program of the Faculty of Business Technologies "Hotel Services Management" — Computer Center 2, 1st floor;

- All master's programs of the Faculty of Power Engineering — Computer Center 1, 6th floor;
- All master's programs of the Faculty of Chemical Technology and Agricultural Sciences — Computer Center 1, 6th floor.

11:00 AM

- All master's programs of the Faculty of Informatics and Control Systems — Computer Center 2, 1st floor;
- All master's programs of the Faculty of Civil Engineering — Computer Center 1, 6th floor.

3. The preliminary results of the specialization exams shall be announced accordingly on

September 5, 2026, and posted on the official university website;

4. Claims (appeals) shall be accepted at the place where the exam was held from September 4 until 2:00 PM on September 7, 2026 (except Sunday); the final results of the specialization exams (taking appeals into account) shall be announced on **September 7, 2026**, and posted on the official university website;

5. The deans of the faculties, based on the results of each part of the Common Master's Exam and the specialization exam (the competition score), shall prepare a faculty ranking document with the master's exam coefficients and a corresponding submission on enrollment in the master's programs, and shall ensure the submission of these documents to the Educational Process Management Service no later than **September 8, 2026**. On the same day, they shall be posted on the official university website;

6. The deans of the GTU faculties shall ensure the conclusion of study contracts with master's candidates from **September 8 through September 12, 2026**, and shall submit the enrollment draft to the Educational Process Management Service on **September 14**;

7. The Educational Process Management Service shall prepare the Rector's unified

administrative-legal act (order) for enrollment in GTU master's programs for the 2026-2027 academic year no later than **October 1, 2026**, and shall ensure its submission to the LEPL National Assessment and Examinations Center and the LEPL National Center for Educational Quality Enhancement within the deadline defined by Order №227 of the Minister of Education and Science of Georgia of April 22, 2009;

8. The management of the master's examination process shall be assigned to D. Kapanadze, Head of the Information Technologies Service, and T. Zhvania, Dean of the Faculty of Informatics and Control Systems;

9. Control over the management of the examination process shall be assigned to Vice-Rector T. Tsereteli;

10. The order shall be posted on the GTU website, and the Human Resources Management Service and the GTU Academic Resources Management and Records Service shall ensure that interested persons are informed of it;

11. The order may be appealed within 1 (one) month of its publication at the Tbilisi City Court (located at: Tbilisi, 64 Davit Aghmashenebeli Alley).
