

RECTOR'S ORDER

GEORGIAN TECHNICAL UNIVERSITY

On Additional Enrollment in Master's Programs

LEGAL BASIS:

Based on the Regulation on the Conduct of Master's Examinations and the Rules for the Distribution of State Educational Master's Grants, approved by Order No. 227 of April 22, 2009 of the Minister of Education and Science of Georgia; the Charter of Georgian Technical University; the Regulation on Magistracy; and Decision N01-05-04/13 of the Academic Council of Georgian Technical University dated February 7, 2025, with the aim of organizing and conducting the enrollment process for master's degree programs at Georgian Technical University for the 2026-2027 academic year:

I ORDER:

1. To announce additional admission to Georgian Technical University's master's degree programs for the vacant positions specified in Appendix 1.
2. Registration of applicants wishing to enroll in master's degree programs at Georgian Technical University shall be conducted on the electronic platform – register.gtu.ge, from 4:00 PM on September 14, 2026 to 6:00 PM on September 15, 2026 (for registration documentation and application form, see Appendices 2 and 3).
3. Faculty deans shall assign responsible persons to verify information submitted by applicants for enrollment (for responsible persons by faculty, see Appendix 4).
4. The admission examination in a foreign language, in accordance with the admission requirements for the master's program, shall be conducted on September 16, 2026 at 10:00 AM at GTU's Building I, Electronic Learning Resources Center (Computer Center 2, First Floor), 68 Kostava Street.
5. Specialization admission examinations for the master's program shall be conducted on September 16, 2026 at 12:00 PM at GTU's Building I, Examination and Electronic Learning Resources Center (Computer Center 2, First Floor), 68 Kostava Street.
6. Initial examination results shall be published on September 16. Appeals shall be received at the examination venue from September 16 to 11:00 AM on September 17. Appeals shall be reviewed on September 17; final examination results (taking into account appeals) shall be published the same day on the University's official website.
7. Based on the results of each part of the general master's examination and the specialization examination (competitive score), the deans of the faculties shall prepare faculty enrollment documents with ranking coefficients of master's examination results and submit appropriate proposals regarding enrollment in master's programs. These documents shall be submitted to the Academic Process Management Office no later than September 18, 2026 at 12:00 PM. On the same day, they shall be published on the University's official website.
8. Faculty deans shall ensure the execution of educational and financial contracts with master's degree candidates from September 18 to 2:00 PM on September 19, 2026 and shall submit enrollment projects to the Academic Process Management Office on the same day.
9. The Academic Process Management Office shall prepare a unified administrative-legal act (order) of the Rector for enrollment in Georgian Technical University's master's degree programs for the 2026-2027 academic year no later than October 1 of this year, and shall ensure its submission within the timeframe established by Order No. 227 of April 22,

2009 of the Minister of Education and Science of Georgia to the National Center for Assessment and Examinations and the National Center for the Development of Education Quality.

10. Registration of applications shall be assigned to the Head of the Department of Human Resources Management and Administrative Affairs, D. Gorgidze.

11. Management of the enrollment process for master's programs shall be assigned to the Head of the Academic Process Management Office, Z. Buachidze.

12. Control over the implementation of this order shall be assigned to Vice-Rector T. Tereteli.

13. The order shall be published on GTU's website and the Department of Human Resources Management and Administrative Affairs shall ensure its notification to interested parties.

14. This order may be appealed within 1 (one) month from the date of publication to the Tbilisi City Court (located at: Tbilisi, David the Builder Avenue, No. 64).
